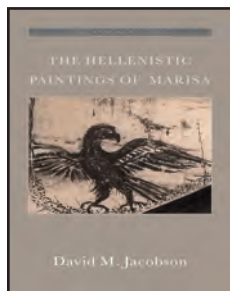


# Palestine Exploration Fund Annuals

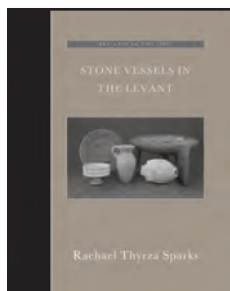


## The Hellenistic Paintings of Marisa (PEF Annual VII) David M Jacobson

This new publication includes, for the first time, the original photographs taken by Raad in 1902, which reveal the fine quality of these ancient works of art.
